* These fees cover additional charges to students electing to study more costly subjects in Stages 5 and 6 which involve consumables and resources.

** Extra curriculum fees, e.g. Band fees, Music camp, Duke of Edinburgh scheme and sports activities are not included in the College Education Fee and will be payable during the year via your school's alternative payment platform (Compass Pay).

Sibling discounts will apply on the Education fee. These discounts provide a 25% reduction for the second child, 55% for the third child and 100% for fourth and subsequent children. Sibling discounts are applicable across systemic secondary and primary schools within the Diocese of Broken Bay. Sibling discounts are only available on application via the Family Registration form.

Students attending systemic schools in the Archdiocese of Sydney, Diocese of Parramatta and the Diocese of Wollongong may also be eligible for sibling discounts on tuition fees.

Billing

School fees are billed annually at the beginning of Term 1 by Catholic Schools Broken Bay and are due in 10 monthly instalments. The first instalment is due 21st of February and the last payment date being 21st November. School fees may be paid more frequently (annually, fortnightly or weekly), however the monthly instalment amount is to be paid by the 21st of the month.

Our preferred method of payment for fees is BPAY. Fees can also be paid by EFTPOS at reception or by credit card over the phone (9977 5111).

If both parents/caregivers signed the original enrolment form, then both parents/caregivers are responsible for payment of the fees unless Split Billing Forms have been completed and submitted to the College.
